



RC SHOW MOVE-OUT INFORMATION

Tuesday, February 27 4:00PM to 10:00PM
Wednesday, February 28 8:00AM to 4:00PM

DEADLINE FOR REMOVAL OF GOODS IS WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 28 at 4:00PM. GOODS LEFT IN THE BUILDING AFTER THE MOVE-OUT DEADLINE WILL BE REMOVED BY RC SHOW MANAGEMENT AT THE EXHIBITOR'S EXPENSE.

No dismantling of exhibits or packing of goods may be done prior to show closing at 4:00pm on Tuesday, February 27th.

Under no circumstances can goods be removed on carts, hand dollies, etc. through the front doors of the building. All removal of goods must be through the rear doors of the building.

Material handling crews will do their best to deliver storage items to you as soon as possible, unless you have made special arrangements. Reshipment of cases requires clear labels and instructions.

During move-out, fork lift operators will assist you with the loading of goods as soon as possible after show closing. Please remember, all aisle carpet must be removed before equipment can begin to operate.

Please remember that it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to insure and safeguard his/her own goods and to ensure their removal as soon as possible.

Most thefts occur during the move-in and move-out period when it is virtually impossible to control the number of people entering and leaving the building. It is a time of great confusion when security guards are not able to identify exactly who people are, where they are going and if they are authorized to be in the building. It is recommended that you wear your exhibitor badge at all times to clearly identify yourself.

Do not leave your booth unattended during move-out while waiting for a truck to load your goods. Items that can be hand-carried or loaded on dollies can easily be stolen from your booth at this time. If you plan to dismantle your booth on the day following show closing, leave only heavy items that are not easily lifted and your exhibit booth itself. If you are concerned about certain products being left overnight, please contact the show office for alternative storage arrangements made with security company onsite.

If you should observe a visitor, exhibitor or suspicious person committing a crime, report it to the show office or show security immediately.

All food & beverage products remaining in cooler/freezer storage trucks after the deadline of Tuesday February 27th 6:00 pm will be donated to Second Harvest – Food Rescue.
