



IMPORTANT- CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

Dear Exhibitor,

As you may know, as a participating exhibitor in the RC Show, you are required to have adequate insurance coverage to protect exhibitors, attendees, show organizers, staff and yourself. There are two options:

OPTION #1: PURCHASE SINGLE EVENT INSURANCE

Restaurants Canada has appointed RC Protects as the recommended insurance supplier for RC Show exhibitors. Complete their application form and submit directly to theshow@restaurantscanada.org.

OPTION #2: EXTEND YOUR OWN INSURANCE

Contact your insurance company to request a Certificate of Insurance with these requirements:

- Coverage dates: Feb. 27-Mar. 4, 2020 (includes move in and out dates)
- Comprehensive General Liability of \$2,000,000
- Personal Injury and Property Damage Liability subject to a maximum \$1,000 Deductible.
- Products and Completed Operations Liability
- Contingent Employers Liability
- Broad form Property Damage
- Cross Liability clause
- Severability of Interest Clause
- RC Show, Restaurants Canada and Enercare Centre to be added as an additional insured but only with respect to its interest in the operations of the named insured

The RC Show does not extend coverage to any exhibits and requires participating exhibitors to submit the Certificate of Insurance 30 days after booth space confirmation.
