



## IMPORTANT- INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Dear Exhibitor,

As you may know, as a participating exhibitor in the RC Show, you are required to have adequate insurance coverage to protect exhibitors, attendees, show organizers, staff and yourself. There are two options:

### **OPTION #1: PURCHASE SINGLE EVENT INSURANCE**

Restaurants Canada has appointed ExhibitorInsurance.com as the recommended insurance supplier for RC Show exhibitors. Complete the application form and submit a copy of your COI to [theshow@restaurantscanada.org](mailto:theshow@restaurantscanada.org).

### **OPTION #2: EXTEND YOUR OWN INSURANCE**

Contact your insurance company to request a Certificate of Insurance with these requirements:

- Coverage dates: Feb. 24-Mar. 2, 2022 (includes move in and out dates)
- Comprehensive General Liability of \$2,000,000
- Personal Injury and Property Damage Liability subject to a maximum \$1,000 Deductible.
- Products and Completed Operations Liability
- Contingent Employers Liability
- Broad form Property Damage
- Cross Liability clause
- Severability of Interest Clause
- RC Show, Restaurants Canada and Enercare Centre to be added as an additional insured but only with respect to its interest in the operations of the named insured
